

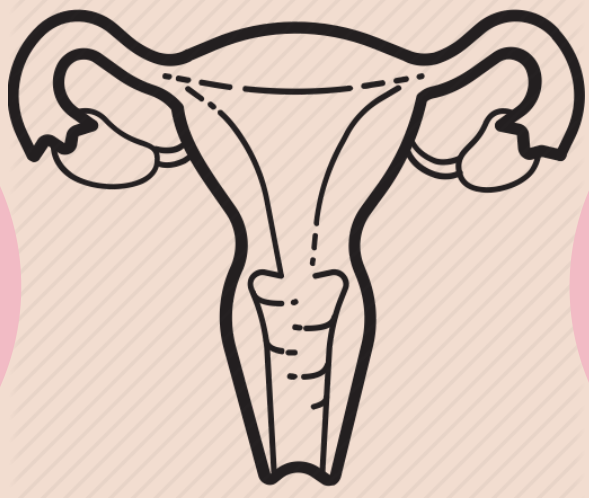
# WOMEN'S REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS

Lack of resources, education, and federal support threaten American women's sexual health.

In 2018, Supreme Court justices, with the Trump administration, threatened to reverse Roe v. Wade

Only 14 states and D.C. have laws that protect the right to abortion.<sup>8</sup>

In the U.S., 62 million women are within childbearing years, and 70% of these women are at risk of unintended pregnancy<sup>1</sup>

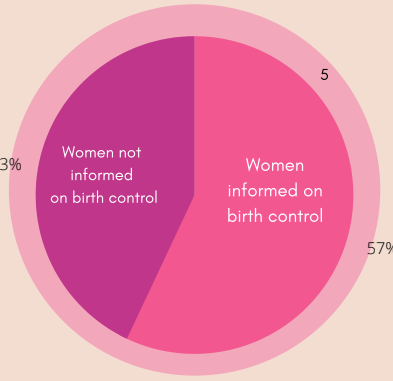
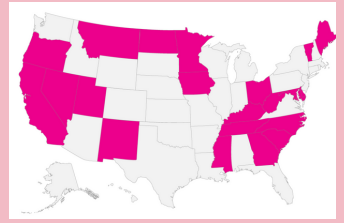


Roe v. Wade is the 1973 U.S. Supreme Court decision that supports women's right to abortion<sup>6</sup>

Before Roe v. Wade ~1.2 million U.S. women had unsafe abortions every year<sup>7</sup>



29 states and D.C. require sex education programs.<sup>2</sup>



Out of pocket cost of birth control pills

Per month: \$5-15

Per year: up to \$600<sup>4</sup>



47 states invest in ineffective "abstinence-only-until-marriage" programs.<sup>3</sup>
